



# How To Keep Your Child's Private Information From Being Released To Military Recruiters

The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 requires schools to release your family's private information to military recruiters unless you "opt out" in writing. Doing so will prevent your school from releasing a students personal information to military recruiters.
